  - what you hope to learn from this experience
  - your interest in healthcare planning/design
  - your career path objectives
3. One page document with:
  - excel table outlining your requested amount
  - proposed budget
  - travel agenda
4. One to Two reference letters from faculty directly involved in the healthcare architecture program or directly involved with the student. (attach as a PDF with the above information)

Applications will be reviewed by the Foundation for Health Environments Research.
